## SAT SUMMER CAMP 2023 OVERVIEW

### Who Should Attend?

10th and 11th graders who have completed Algebra II and English II.

### When are the SAT sessions and how much do they cost?

- **Session One: July 3 - 28**
  - Full Session: Mon - Fri 10am - 1pm: \$1,350
- **Session Two: July 31 - Aug 25**
  - Full Session: Mon - Fri 10am - 1pm: \$1,350

### How is the SAT camp structured?

Each week will focus on a new content area, and through supplemental materials and homework assignments, students will acquire a strong foundation in the fundamental concepts necessary for success. In class, the instructors will assess and identify areas of weakness and provide support in those target areas. Every Friday, students will have a chance to practice utilizing their newly acquired skills in a mock test setting.

Our SAT Math Summer Camp prepares students for the Math section of the SAT Exam. Students will explore, learn, and develop the skills needed for the four main content areas on the math portion of the SAT Exam: Heart of Algebra, Problem Solving & Data Analysis, Passport to Advanced Algebra, and Additional Topics. Each week will focus on a new content area, and through supplemental materials and homework assignments, students will acquire a strong foundation in the fundamental concepts necessary for success.

Our SAT Verbal Summer Camp prepares students for the Reading & Writing and Language sections of the SAT Exam. Students will explore, learn, and develop the skills needed for the three main content areas of the Reading portion of the SAT Exam: Information & Ideas, Rhetoric, and Synthesis. Within these categories, students will enhance their abilities in reading and comprehending texts of varied genres, purposes, subjects, and complexities. Additionally, students will exercise skills for the two main content areas of the Writing and Language portion of the SAT Exam: Expression of Ideas and Standard English Conventions.

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## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **If my child knows math and verbal very well is SAT prep necessary?**

Yes. Knowing the concepts is very different from identifying them in story problems and applying them in a test scenario. Our SAT camp teaches students to identify the patterns, concepts and how to apply them based on tricky or misleading question formats.

### **How much homework is required for students?**

Students will be provided with 1-2 hours of homework daily. Students are highly recommended to complete the homework but it is not required.

### **When should students take the SAT?**

The Collegeboard.org offers many SAT test dates each year. We recommend students taking the soonest SAT after the SAT camp so the concepts are still fresh in their minds.

### **How many SAT tests will students take?**

Students will take one real SAT exam every week with a total of four per session.

### **Will the content and information provided in both sessions be the same?**

No, the class content will not be the same. Most of the content areas and concepts are the same but our instructors customize the class content and focus based on student needs and challenges. Also, as SAT tests are distinct, the problems and solutions are never the same. As a result, most students take both sessions.

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
